## **Montana Meth Prevention Lesson Video**

### **Independent Study Assignments**

These independent study assignments/lesson extensions reinforce curriculum presented in the video and allow students to dive deeper into learning the effects of Meth use and practicing peer advocacy.

#### **Writing Project**

Assume the role of a recovering Meth addict as if you were writing to the Montana Legislature, following the directions and assignment format at [Meth Project R.A.F.T.](#)

#### **Data Analysis**

Review the regional data from the [Youth Risk Behavior Survey](#). Compare variables from two different regions to see if you can find any patterns. Create a graph of the variables you compared showing a visualization of your trend analysis.

#### **Video Script**

Write a video script for an advertisement persuading people to avoid using Meth, following the instructions at [Meth Awareness Advertisement](#).

#### **Awareness Poster**

Create a poster to “unsell” Meth with a visual representation of its harmful effects. Incorporate at least three statistics from [MethProject.org](#) to accompany your picture or graphic.

#### **Social Media Post**

Create a social media graphic and accompanying post copy that dissuades people from trying Meth. Use at least three impactful statistics and/or effects of Meth use from [MethProject.org](#) that will influence your post followers. Tag @MontanaMeth when you post.
